To the President of the University of Oregon:

It is the consensus of opinion of the Black Student Union that the Office of Minority Relations continue to function. As Donald Warfield has resigned as Director of OMR, affective June 30, 1969, the B.S.U. feels that Johnny C. Holloway should be appointed as Director of OMR.

The B.S.U. also feels that OMR should become more affective in dealing with the problems of Minority Students. With this thought in mind, we feel that OMR should be funded through September, 1969 in order to plan its function during the academic year, September, 1969 through June, 1970, with Johnny C. Holloway as its Director.
