The bombing or explosion in Prince Lucien Campbell Hall last night was an outrageous act that goes beyond--far beyond--legitimate protest. It was senseless lawlessness. It was senseless and self-defeating in that it can only create frustration and anger in the people of this community and State. It was a vicious act that sets into motion its own reaction. We are thankful that no one was killed or hurt.

The police were involved immediately for this is, of course, a matter for law enforcement agencies. We hope with every citizen in this state that the culprits are identified and prosecuted.
