Dear Sir

I inclose herewith regulations
and Census and promise return for
the guide of Agents in their respective
Districts during existing hostilities
as stated in the regulations, if you
deem it absolutely necessary in order
to maintain peace. You will act upon
the general orders ^{stating caution} and assist in
the expenditures under the head of adjusting
difficulties and preventing outbreaks

but you will incur no expense
unless deemed absolutely necessary.

The instructions on the subject apparently
apply to supersede the necessity of
additional explanations. Be vigilant
and arrest all ^{and on others} ~~strange~~ ^{and suspicious}
persons who may be suspected of
exciting discord. Advise me of your
action in the premises, and of the feelings of
the Indians in your district.

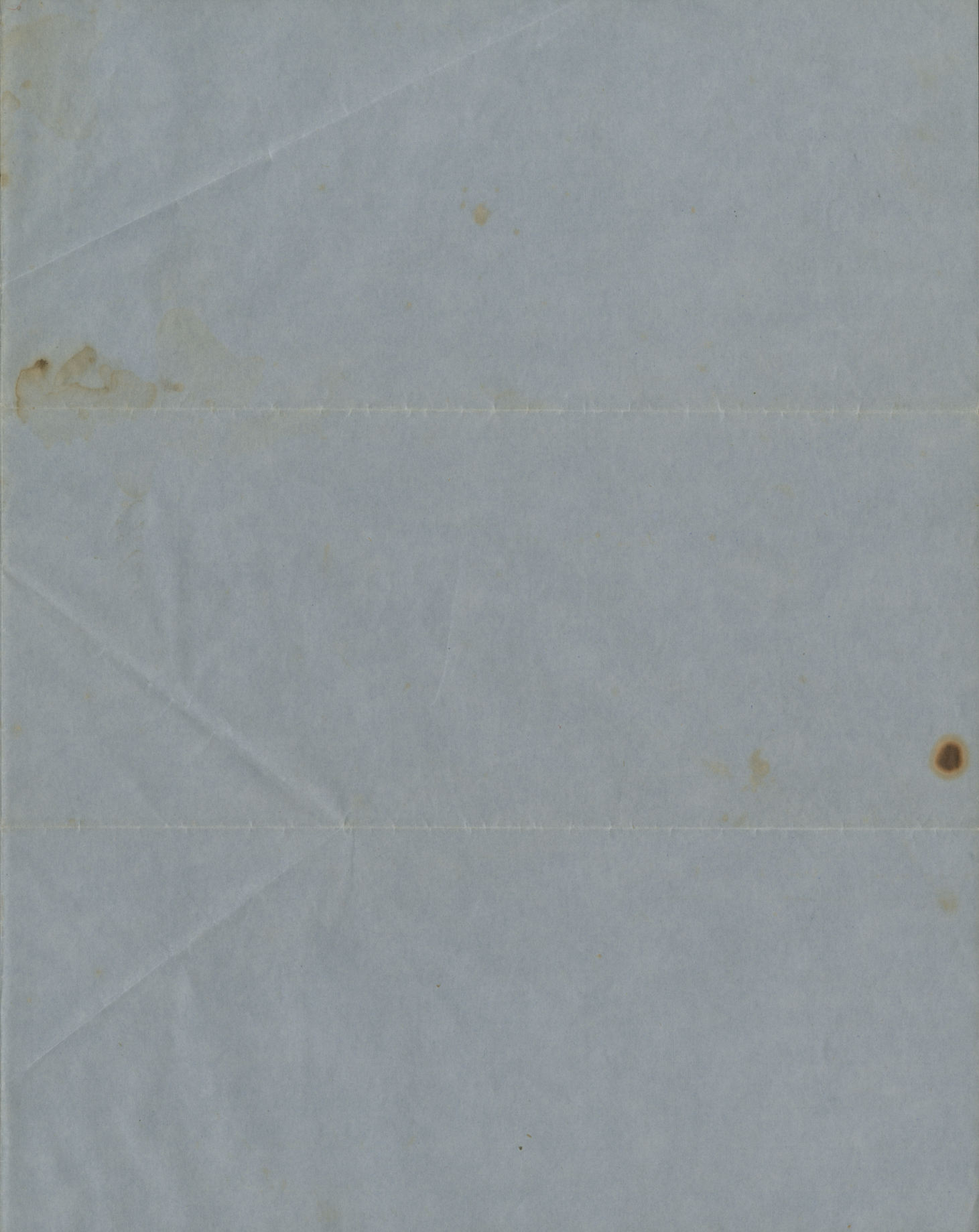
