



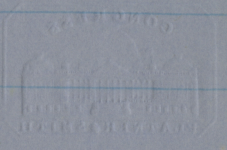

Sir:

You will doubtless recollect the arrangement we made last fall respecting two bales of Blankets which were turned over to the Quar: Master at the Dalles for the use of the Volunteers, ~~the two~~ ^{and which} bales contained, each, fifty pairs, 3 point, Mackinac Blankets, ^{each bale} The Quar: Master at Putland subsequently forwarded to the Indian Agent at the Dalles, two bales of Hudson's Bay Blankets which contained but twenty five pairs each, leaving fifty pairs yet unreturned. If it be convenient I would be pleased to have the deficiency supplied as we are now in need of them - a much larger quantity having been required of late than was anticipated: They may be forwarded to the Dalles, or to this place as may suit your convenience, we need Blankets at both points.
