Dear Sir

By the last steamer I received notice that
a number of my accounts for Indian service had
been suspended by the accounting officers at Washington
City, Amery which one of your freight
bills amounting to \$196.¹⁰/₁₀₀. This suspension
is in consequence of not having the receipts of
the parties for amounts paid them for charges
below -

Please obtain and send me the receipt for the two

Pkg's weighing 4000 lbs C 60 ct \$24.00

to Canema \$26.25
