



City and Agency Dec 28<sup>1892</sup>

Memorandum of matter of difference between Adams & his wife Frances, sister of Chief George Barney. Adams makes application for a decree of divorce from Frances. Frances objects. and the matter is submitted to the decision of the court of Arbitrators or jury. <sup>Members</sup> elected in general council. There being present - Jack of Eugene Bird, Hamith Chug, Jerry Cap and Mr. Strong. Eugene Johnson having resigned.

The jury heard the statements of both Parties and decided that no offense had been committed by Adams to justify a decree of divorce - but that Frances should pay the cost of the suit. The decree was approved by one and after giving a little advice, the case was dismissed.
