

This Article of Agreement made and entered  
into this 26th day of April AD 1849 between William  
P Bryant of the City of Oregon of the first part and  
Sgt G.W. Hawkins acting assistant quarter Master USA  
of the second part witnesseth that the said party of the  
first doth agree and bind himself to deliver to the  
said party of the second part at the Town of Portland on  
the Willamette River in said Territory on or before the  
day of July 1849 three hundred and fifty thousand  
feet of good merchantable lumber, the same to  
be of sufficient size, and suited to the construction  
and completion of six frame buildings to be  
forty five feet in length by thirty four in breadth  
and two stories high (Excepting the Shingles for  
said buildings.) All the said lumber for said frames  
to be sawed and the residue of said three hundred  
and fifty thousand feet to be inch boards work straight  
edges said lumber to be delivered by the first day of  
July 1849 for which the said party of the second part  
doth agree to pay the said party at the rate of  
eighty five dollars per thousand feet as soon as  
one thousand feet is delivered to pay for the same and  
the balance upon the completion of the said Contract  
and if the ship Massachusetts is ready to receive  
said lumber or any other Gov. vessel the said ship  
is to take said lumber from the raft, otherwise  
said party of the first part is to pile said lumber  
on the Bank of said stream as we have our  
hands
