

The following articles were delivered this day June 11th 1855, to Weyatenamany, the Head Chief of the Cayuses, as per agreement in Council, the same being given for the benefit of the Cayuse bands of Indians, as part consideration for the purchase of their lands, the value of which is in addition to any other consideration mentioned in the Treaty: to wit
