 11th June 1855 to Wenap-^{oo}not head chief
 of the Umatillas as per agreement in Council,
 the same being given for the benefit of the
 Umatilla Bands of Indians as part consideration
 for the purchase of their lands, The value
 of which is in addition to any other consi-
 -deration named in the Treaty. To wit
