

The following articles <sup>were</sup> delivered this June 11<sup>th</sup> 1855 to Pi-pio Noe-moe head chief of the Wallawallas as per agreement in council, the same being given for the benefit of the Wallawalla bands of Indians as part consideration for the purchase of their lands, The value of which is in addition to any other consideration named in the Treaty.
