To Mr Joel Palmer

Dear Sir This is to acknowledge
the receipt of Eight hundred dollars
by the hand of John Green For W W Raymond

two thousand dollars, and as there appear

glad to have another favour as I still have
about five hundred against him which he
always says shall be paid first And that
he wishes all sent to my care &c
