Between Wm. H. Wright of the first part & Benj. Wright of the second part - The party of the first do bargain and sell to Benj. Wright of the second part all his right title & interest in his farm containing three hundred & twenty acres - the interest of Wm. H. Wright of the second part being the undivided half of the above described farm -

The above farm is located on Rogue river near the Mouth in Coos County

Wm. H. Wright of the first part also bargains & sells to Benj. Wright of the second part the undivided half of the crop now growing on said farm including tools & farming implements - In addition to the above

Wm. H. Wright of the first part sells to Benj. Wright of the second part three horses, described as follows - A, Dum horse a sorrel & ball faced - a rone split ears

Benj. Wright of the second part pays the party of the first part for the above described property three hundred dollars
