The bill of Lading attached covers part of a bill of goods purchased by the United States from Grant and Barton Aug 21st 1854 at their Stores Nos 123, 125 William Street New York and shipped by the Shipper Ship Challenge as per bill of Lading do to New York Aug 23rd 1854 The packages are all the same as when shipped from New York except No 1000 which was a bale of Scarlet 3 pr Blankets, very badly damaged by Salt Water on the voyage of importation and part of Bale No 915 also damaged partially, from the same cause. These have been sold (Bale 1000, and 10 prs from 915) by Green of Port Marden and Underwriters agent for and on acct of New York Underwriters, the balance of the bale 915 are repack'd in a box No. 915 and some of them are damaged or stained.
