and Sold unto Joel Palma, all my right title and Interest to
the land claim and the improvements thereon, known as Samuel
Keith, claim, situated on the South Bank of the Columbia River
between Taylors and William Ferris land claims, containing
One hundred and Sixty acres, for the sum of One Hundred
and Seventy five dollars, being the amount claimed as a
consideration for the improvements on said claim. The receipt
