Sir

I started by land for the
Dulles in the morning I do not think I
shall call on you at Dayton on my way as
it is doubtful whether I would find you
there, I have turned over to Mr. W. Dunbar
such article of property as I have on hand at
this place. Enclosed please find his receipt for
the same. Upon its receipt please forward to me
at the Dulles your receipt in exchange for
Dunbar's. Glad to say, that an Agent
is needed very much in this part of the
country. The business of the ^{Agency} is not more than
half wound up. besides there is a great many
Indians still in the mountains, especially on the
Coquille River
