Geo. W. Woods, is about six
feet high, large frame, & a large
man. He has black hair, blue
eyes & dark complexion. He
was from Wayne County Indiana
but for a few years before coming
to this country, was a resident of
New Castle, Henry County Indiana

He came to Cal^a in 1849. I was
last heard from at Olympia
W.T. in '54 or '55. We had some
rumor that he had joined one
of the volunteer companies from
that place, & was killed by the
Indians. What his occupations
were here I do not know, he had

been accustomed to Mercantile
pursuits before coming to this
country

In your travels through
the country please make in-
quiries about him & if you
should hear any thing of him
I would be under many obligations
to you would let me know, I
will be probably for some years
at San Francisco, but a letter
at any time sent to me through
the Dr. Mas, at Barcelona will al-
ways find me
