Mrs Palmer & Robie

I was at the Fort where
Capt. Hughs Hawley & Childs wanted to make an
arrangement for a large lot of Lumber and
wanted us to read the price they said they
would want 40 or 50 thousand feet I informed
them that it was our intention to have but one
price but I would take the responsibility to
sell them not less than 40 thousand and all over
that they wanted of Common Lumber at \$60 per
thousand if they would keep it quiet - now
probably I have not done as you would wish
but I think it will pay as well as to see
small bill I hope this will meet with your
approval - among more lumber you send to
me send principally flooring & inch boards -
I gave a letter of introduction to your Genl.
to a Judge Waite I don't know much about
him only that he was introduced to me by
Major Sargent so you will know what
Waite to give it
