Ms. Palmer Dear sir after  
so long I take this present opportunity  
to write a few lines to you to let you  
know what I have done with the cattle  
I have sold all of them but these head  
and they were strayed a way from Mr. Gaylord  
at the time I took the others a way  
he has found one since and probably has  
found the others before this time I was not  
able to sell them until in January then  
I traded off <sup>five</sup> ~~three~~ of the largest ones  
that were thin in flesh for six fat  
cows I found the three head that stray-  
ed from Mc Donald and Burch I had to  
pay for \$300 for to get them I sold them  
at the following prices the three cows  
and calves I sold to Gaylord last fall  
for one hundred and twenty five dollars  
and note until June for the money  
two others for seventy five two for \$100 00  
two \$110 00 two for \$111 00 two for \$81 00  
and I sold one half of light head at the rate of  
\$315 00 dollars for the lot and drove them  
over here and butchered them amounting in all  
to \$822 00 I did not settle the Ranch bill  
with Gaylord it will be a bout \$50

and they 33 00 dollars for finding they  
three head that wee strayed & paid all so  
they Burches ranch bill of 25 00 dollars

so that of ter paying they bills on them  
they have brought a bout 430 00 dollars  
and one more probably three more to sell

I am now staying on Garden creek Arizoa

and unless I follin off aftare some nerve  
excitement I will stay here this summer

I think this country will be next to Washoe  
we certainly have some very rich parts

Rock here and they are a striking new  
pages all most every day both silver and  
gold bearing parts they claimer that

Coffin took up here last fall would sell  
easily at \$12 00 per foot Jones went on  
and represented them for him so understand  
that there is two parts mills ordered for this  
place that will be here buy the first of

July I have got feet in several ledges  
they places diging are very good but they  
are not equal to Bonnick and are limited

I would like to hear from you and know  
whether you are a coming to they mines  
this summer or please write to me and

direct to Idaho city if you dont come out  
I will send you they balance due you as you  
may direct I still have old Cobins

so I have no more to write at present
