

Oppenheimer abstract C 2<sup>d</sup> of 1855

"House of Brewster & Co &c

In the duplicate of this house the brewer  
receives from \$553 instead of \$533 as stated in  
the remittance - The original bill was for \$605.

but Mr Culver had advanced him \$52 - which  
was deducted as shown on the Receipt and  
no claim has been set up for the original  
amount but only as less than received <sup>for</sup> \$553.  
<sup>on Jan 2<sup>nd</sup> 1854</sup> Mr Culver returned <sup>which he purchased</sup> ~~not paid for~~ <sup>Subsequently</sup> ~~from~~ <sup>for</sup> the Culver certificates to the purchase, and ~~which~~ <sup>or</sup> ~~or~~ <sup>for</sup>  
from the articles on his property return

~~However~~ for the delay was in consequence of the  
parties not calling for the amount. Mr Culver  
at the time Mr Culver received the articles  
he had no funds in his hands. And the delay  
was in consequence of his <sup>now</sup> ~~not~~ calling for the amount.

I send the account upon the certificates of Mr Culver & Co,  
these articles had been purchased - and upon the  
brevelees are stated that such had been obtained  
time by Mr Culver - and by entry that the  
account is correct and just and that the same actually  
this twelfth day of May 1858 paid the account
