It is hereby agreed that as soon as practicable after the selection of a residence for the said band of Indians there shall be erected at some suitable point or points, a saw mill - and blacksmith shop for the mutual benefit of said band and such other band or bands as may be located contiguous each band or Tribe sharing in its advantages in proportion to the number of persons comprising each band respectively, the erection of which together with the necessary machinery and fixtures tools iron and steel, and all necessary expenses attending the maintaining and continuing in successful operation for materials as well as labour, except as hereinafter provided, for <sup>twenty</sup> years, shall be born by the United States

Article

It is hereby stipulated that it shall be competent for the Superintendent or agent, under such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by order of the President of the United States or Commissioner of Indian Affairs, to apprentice a suitable number of <sup>boys or</sup> young men to learn the art of attending the saw mill and the trade of blacksmithing, and such other branches as may be deemed necessary to be taught the above named band of Indians. And when so apprenticed it is hereby made the duty of their chiefs and head men of said band to aid in enforcing in observance of such articles of Apprenticeship. provided however that no apprentice shall be required to reside or perform service at any <sup>points or branches</sup> ~~points~~ other than the <sup>and hereby</sup> shops engaged in the service of the Indian Tribes
