to Mr Bills \$13.47

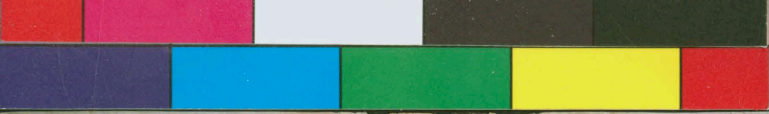
The proceeds of the office

Which, so far as my books show  
Mr Bills is accountable for to the 30<sup>th</sup> June  
last, and whatever accrued thereafter, which

his bail, of course, will be held account-  
able — I suppose Mr B. had a book  
of instructions, which with the blanks  
and other instructions belonging to the  
office, he should have with you.

the Department months ago, & you  
will doubtless receive it soon
