at tha request of some of tha  
Sitasons that Emroyated in fifty  
one and had thear Horses stolen  
by tha Digers as I wold have a  
grate deal of this proper ty that  
was sole ing that year of soliz



by the owners to undertake to try  
to recover their property - This is a thing  
that I did not think of when I was  
at your house but being solicited  
by Mr Clark my neighbor and others  
I have concluded to ask for the post  
through you Sir and if you will give  
me the a point ment from Mr  
Parmer I will in deavour to attend  
to the duties of the office to the  
best of my judgment and skill  
Just as soon as I get the road
