Len Palmer Sir

I now have the opportunity of sending you a few lines we are water bound and in all probability will be for one or two weeks the streams is up swarming and still raining day and night. We have had a rainy muddy trip so far I have some notion of going to hunt some pack animals and go to Martins and deliver the goods to him leave the team here till we return and bring them back to you

Bill is fishing team and horse on good grass and we the best we can which tolerable rough we are well and hearty

tell Mrs Hubbard I am well for I have not time to write to her now

You may be assured we will be back as soon as possible
