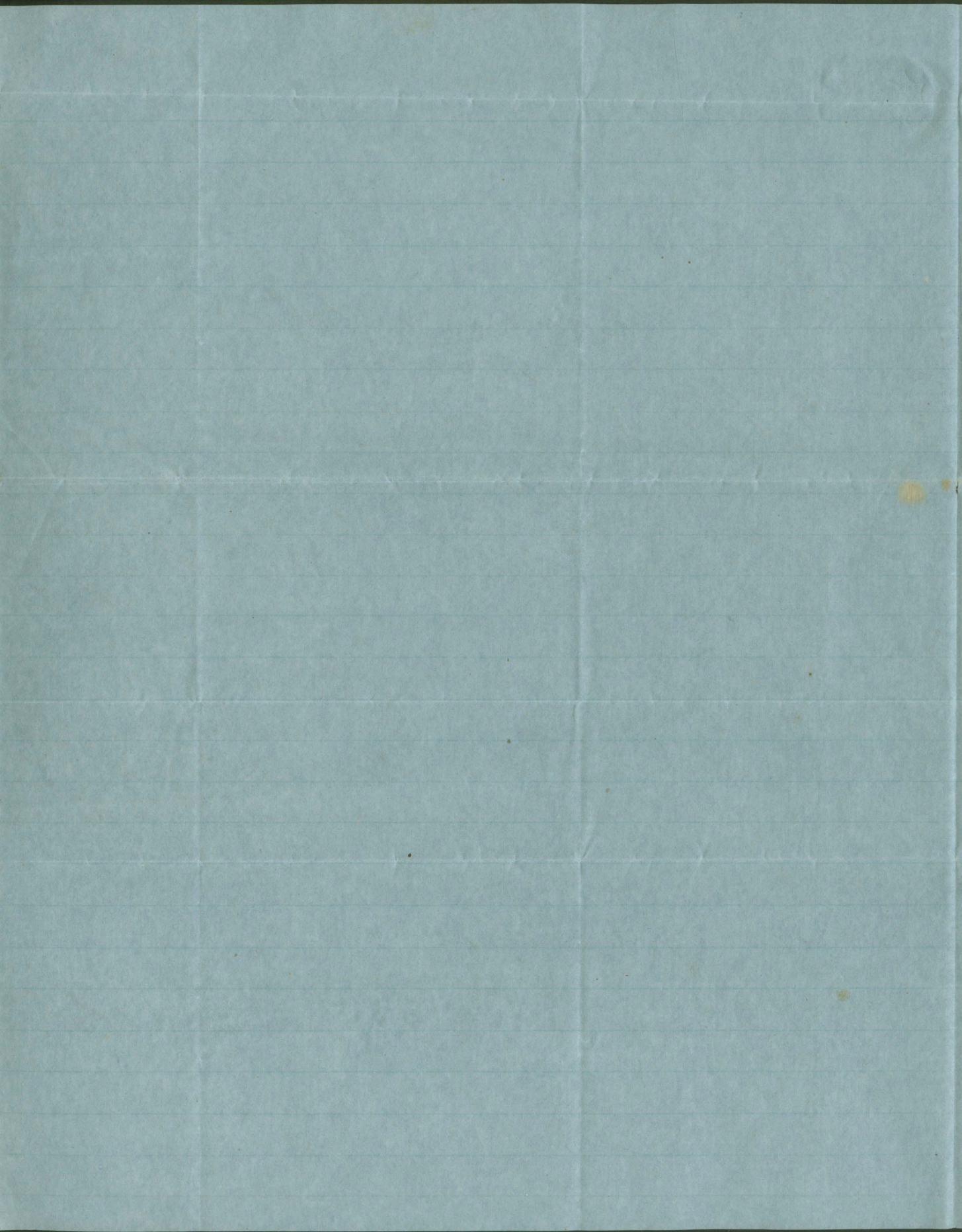
By the advice of the Commanding

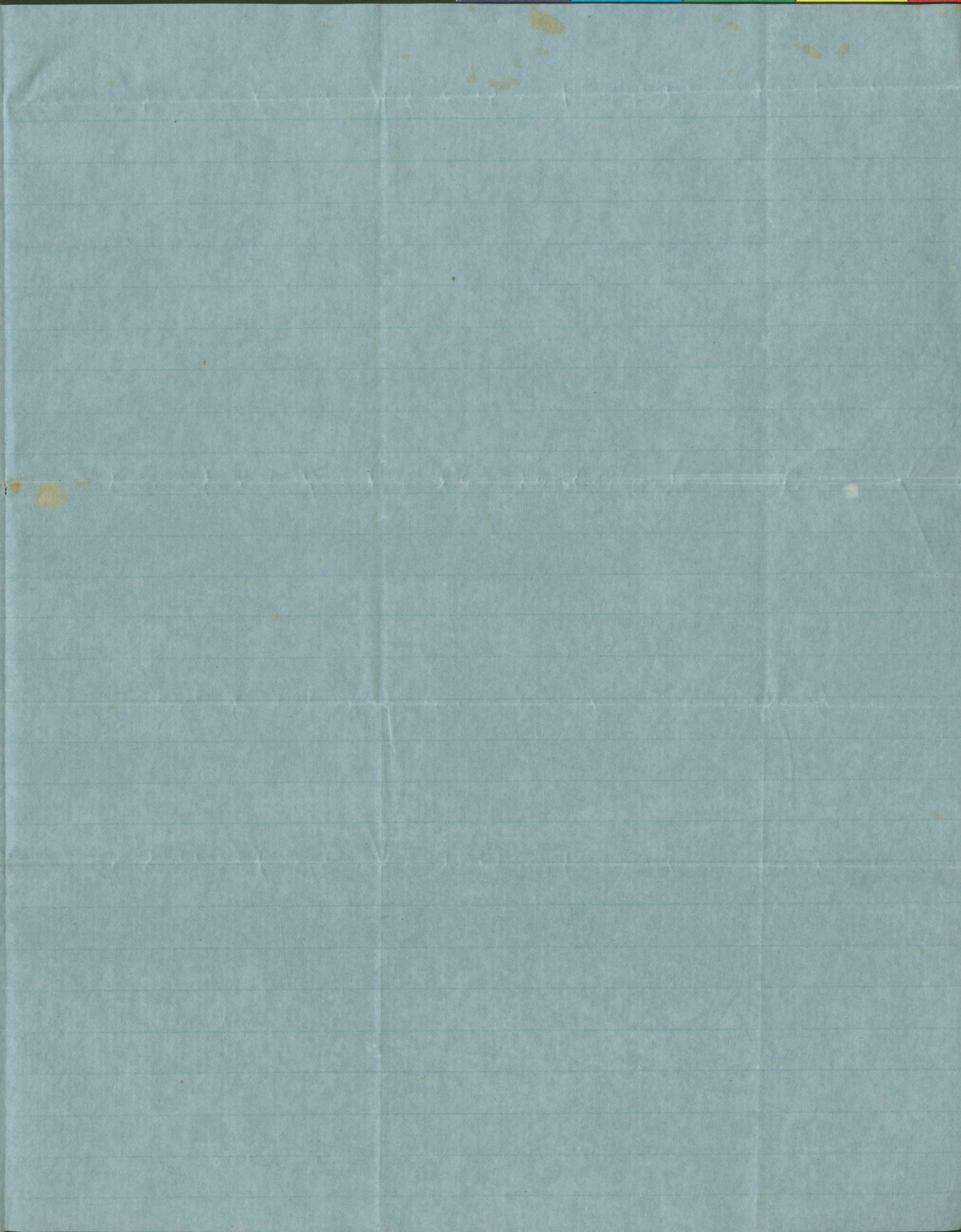
