Warrived here last evening all well we recd
all our goods ~~at~~ at Kellier in good order
~~and~~. We had rather an interesting time with the
lower house of Eucar there number our
Zaylor send you. The people here are much
gratified to see us, tomorrow we have a talk
with them we shall next proceed to the
Mackonstun then to the sixto-costar and
return. Last evening I recd a letter from
Chitko urging our visit there the Indians
are represented as coming in and want to
see us I hope soon to be there here
brother in meeting and I must close
I have the honor to be your Obedt

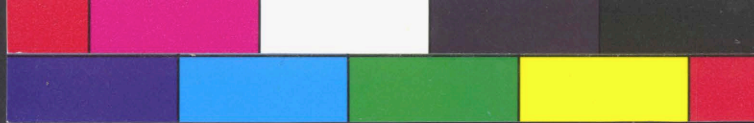
