Dear Sir

Please to send by the bearer of this note all the Mills Irons and fixtures that may not have been brought by M. Monahan's team if this team cannot bring all, and any thing has to be left let it be the water wheel please send a Pilot oraining each Iron so that if any thing is lost it can be ascertained who lost the Iron

I shall be down at the game Hill about 10 o'clock

No Indian difficulties yet as has been anticipated in the South nor will there be in my opinion It also appears of some of the old Citizens of Rye Valley that they will remain at peace this season
