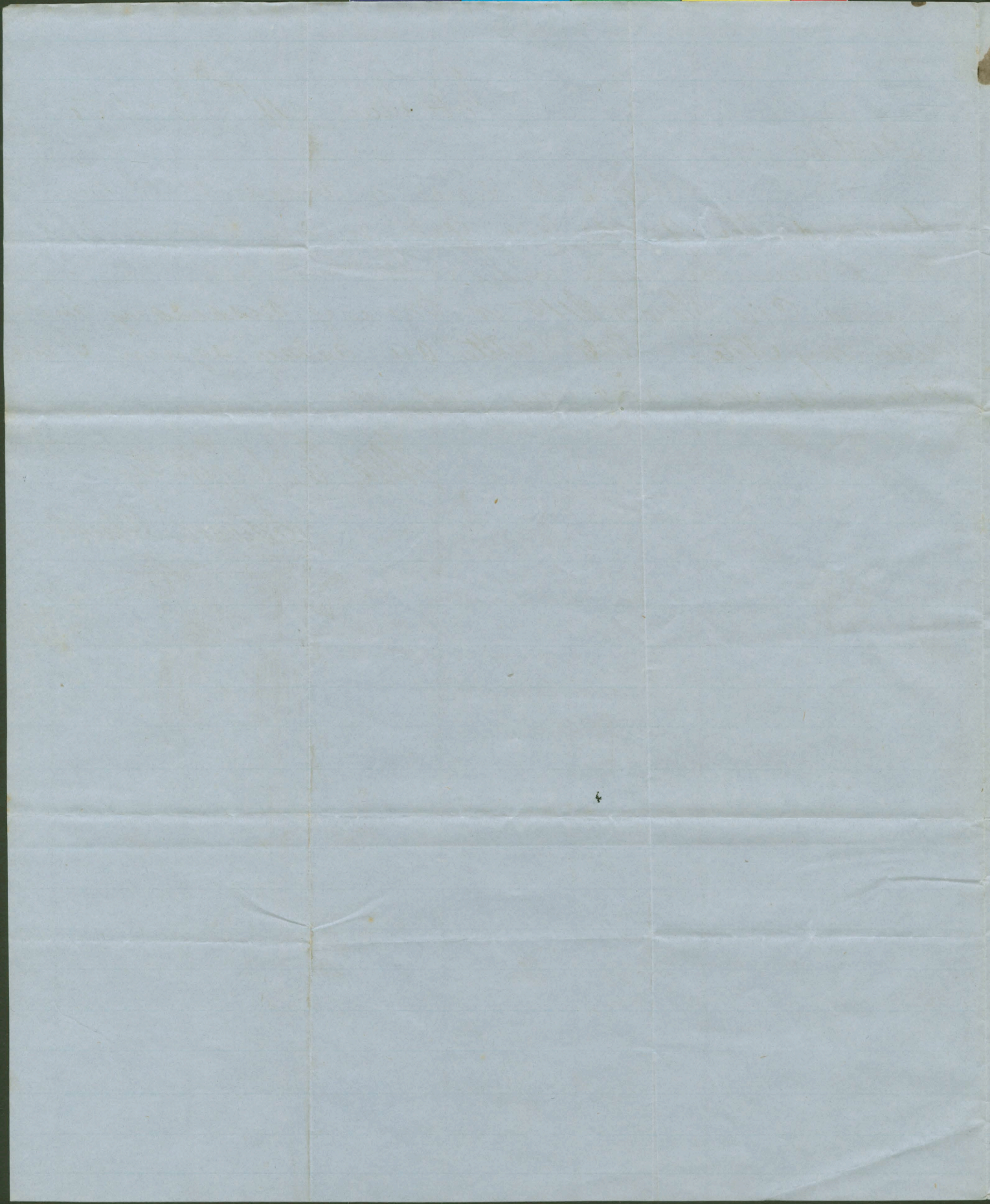


Post Lane 24th Nov 1854
