Mr Parmer Dear sir

you promised me you wold write to me and let me know whether my claim on the Rogue-River Indians could be paid out of their annuity or not I have not got ^{that} letter and I do suppose the answer you got from wasington was unfavourable to me or you would have witen to me be fore now

The object of this communication is to request you to ask congress to make an appropriation to pay all such claims as mine I suppose you know about how much it will take to do it

I have no doubt if all such claims were paid there would be less diffculty betwean those Indians and the white people and I think if you would urg on congress the necessity of the appropriation they would make it and there by I get my money
