

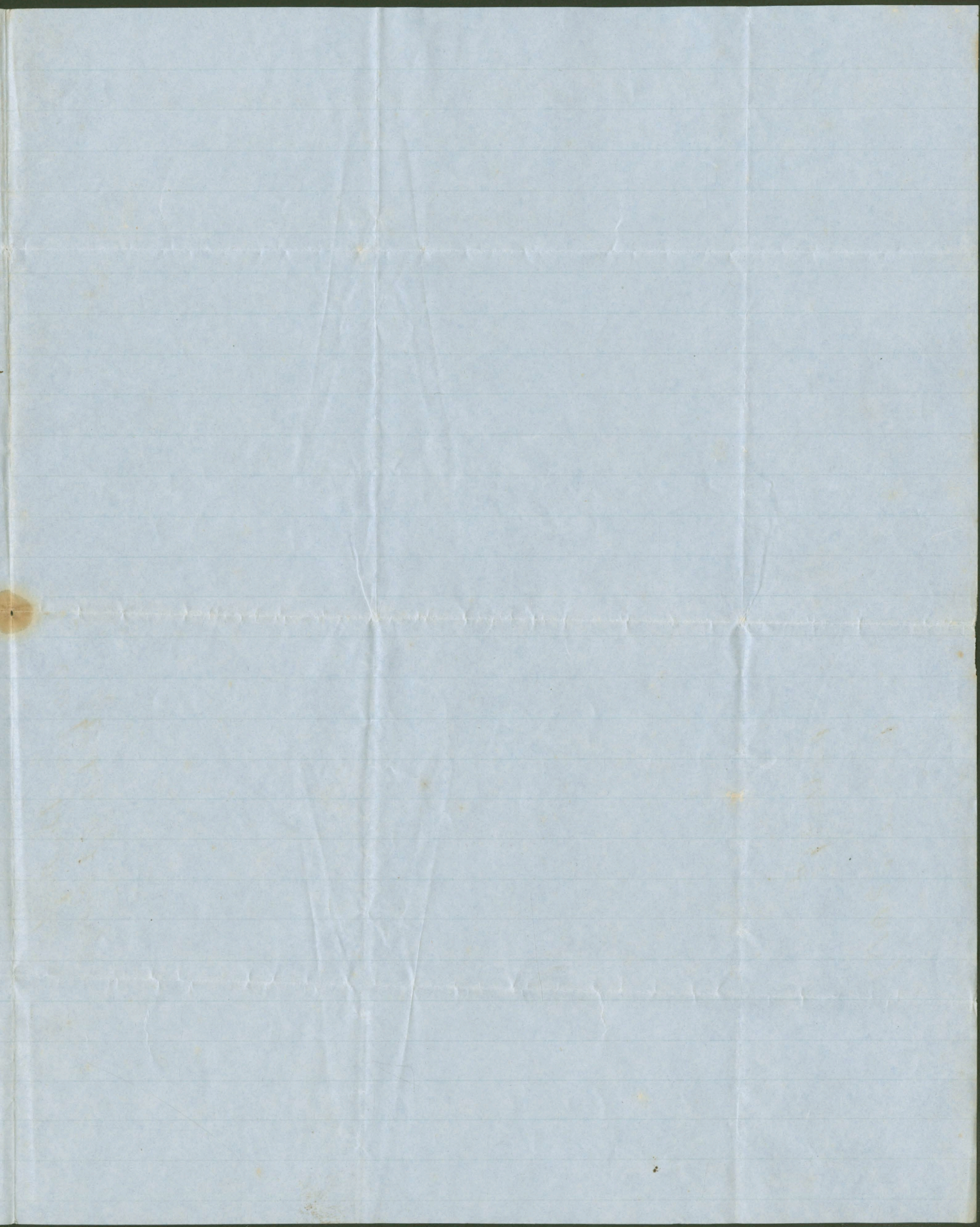
Port Orford April the 10th / 55
