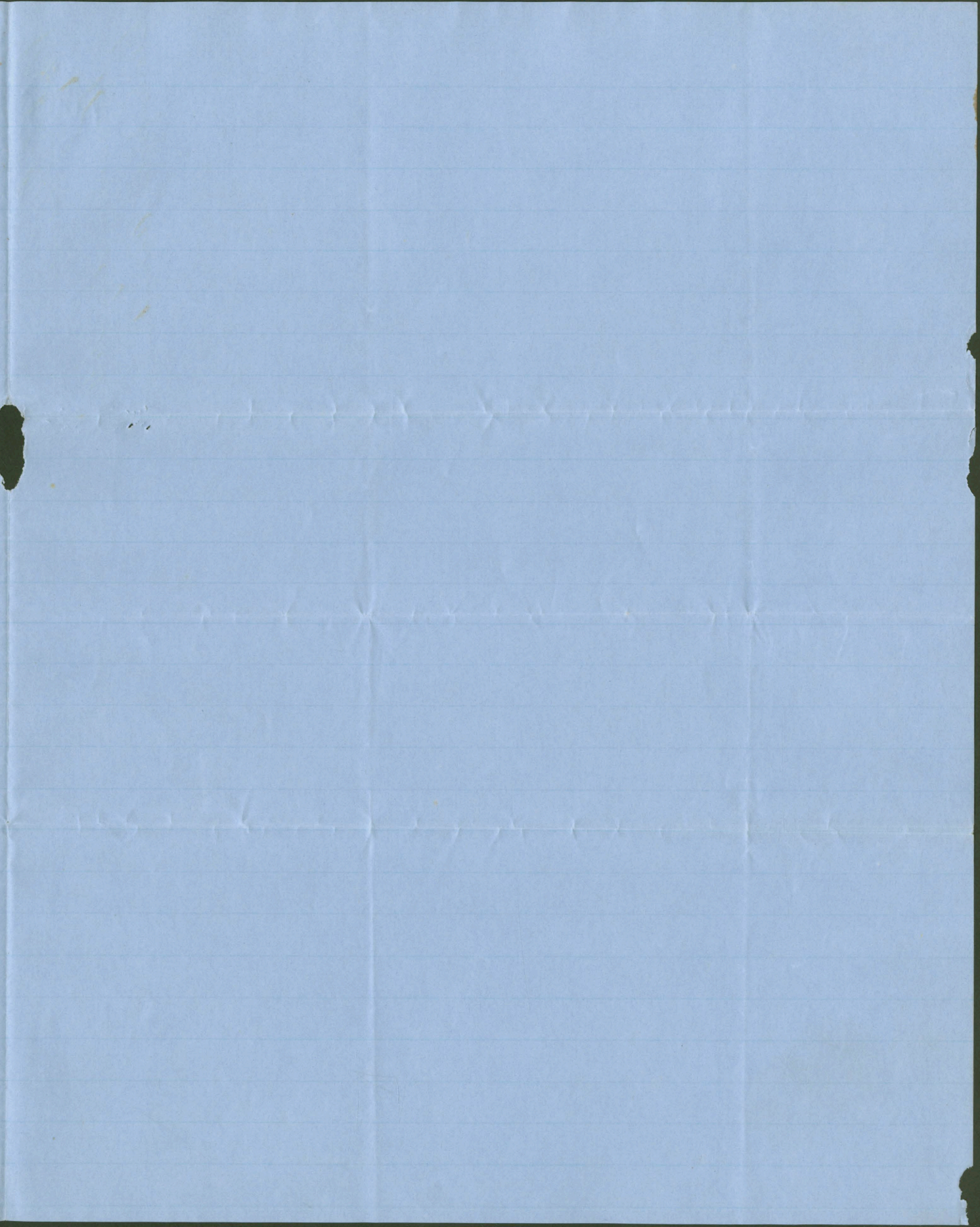
Dear Sir herewith I enclose a
