WATER PURIFICATION PLANT

An ID 325.75 million contract won by a number of foreign firms to construct one of the largest water purification plants in the world has been signed by the Mayor of Baghdad, and the General Company for Water and Sewage Contracting.

The 200 million gallon-a-day filtration plant can be increased to 300 million gallons.

4 tanks will also be set up in Baya, Taji, Abou Ghraib, and Kadhimiyah districts of Baghdad with a total storage capacity of 160 million gallons.

In addition, a distribution network of pipes, 200 km in length, is to be built in Karkh district.
