p. 8-10 Egypt: Self-Governing Authority (the SGA) will replace the military gov. & civilian administration. SGA authority will extend to all areas occupied after June 5, 1967, applying to the land as well as all inhabitants, including settlers. The SGA will assume responsibility for "natural resources".

p. 10-11 Israel: Israel leaves open the question of sovereignty "for the sake of peace".  
The ~~militarist~~ The military govt will remain as a legislative, executive, & judicial body & the constitutional authority for the elected "administrative council". Security will be in Israeli hands, & the IDF will remain. Settlement will continue. "State lands & lands declared as such will be in Israeli possession. Israel will control water sources." In short, this will be a "personal-communal", not territorial autonomy.

p. 181-83 Rengan: "Full autonomy means authority over "land and its resources, subject to fair safeguards on water." East Jerusalem subject
