

## The Policy of Planning and Developing

### The Water Industry in the 1980's

- The major goals: 1) to develop the remaining water resources - rain water and brine water from one aquifer; 2) reclamation of urban sewage water; 3) the restoration of hydrological deficits; 4) to preserve and restore the quality of water.
- The quota policy would be adjusted to the needs of the economy: 1) the water need in established agriculture would be based on a "freeze" at the level of the 1970's; 2) the gradual increase of reclaimed water as part of the quota; 3) the increase of urban quotas would be conditioned on improvements in the improvement in the urban network.
- The preservation of the quality of water.
- Projections of Water Potential (see Table on p. 72)
- The Restoration of the Hydrological Deficit: 1) recharge, 40 mcm; the reclamation (the only potential left 400 mcm)
- The Creation of the Department for Planning and Developing of Water and the Agricultural Infrastructure.
