5. U. Shamid Interview

- Q. You have suggested the Water Commissioner to consider changes about de-centralization of the water industry management. Did it have any effect?
- A. It was suggested that a new reality formed recently in the water industry—
 is to be taken into account. This referred to the fact of the establishment
 of "Water User Associations" that aim to manage (plan, construct and operate)
 their water systems this -in- some contradiction to "Mekorot" (to some
 extent -also "TAHAL") government companies duties of doing the same centrally,
 all over the country. This was suggested about 4 years ago and it had no real
 affect.
- Q. Will you raise this problem again?
- A. Now it seems that the momentum of that new trend has weakened and now it seems that the de-centralization demands by the users are decreasing to the degree that organizational changes about this matter are neither obvious nor urgent.
