Dear Colonel Shalev,

Colonel Tilletson reports that work
was started at MR 208.8-267.6 on 2 September on a new
irrigation project, the details of which were not communicated
to him until 7 September in a conversation held between 0900Z
and 1400Z. In such circumstances he has not been in a position
to discharge his responsibilities under Article 5 of the
Armistice Agreement and Dr.Bunche's authoritative comment
accepted by both Parties to the Armistice Agreement. Colonel
Tilletson was definitely assured yesterday by Captain Reichmann
in the presence of Colonel Shalev that the project did not include
the building of a dam which would in particular flood the island
approximately at MR 208.8-267.5. I am, however, informed that
work with a view to damming the western channel of the Jordan
has started this morning, with the consequence that the island,
which is, I understand, Arab-owned, will be flooded.

I urge that working on the proposed dam be stopped and that I, as Chairman of the Mixed Armistice Commission, receive full information on the proposed new project.

I urge that working on the proposed dam be stopped and that, I, as Chairman of the Mixed Armistice Commission receive full information on the proposed new project.
