THE PALESTINE QUESTION  
France draft resolution

The Security Council,

Having taken note of the report of the Chief of Staff of the Truce Supervision Organization dated 23 October 1953 (S/3122),

Desirous of facilitating the consideration of the question, without however prejudicing the rights, claims or position of the parties concerned,

seems it desirable to that end that the works started in the Demilitarized Zone on 2 September 1953 should be suspended during the urgent examination of the question by the Security Council,  
Notes with satisfaction the statement made by Israel representative at the 631st meeting regarding the undertaking given by his Government to suspend the works in question during that examination,  
Requests the Chief of Staff of the Truce Supervision Organization to inform it regarding the fulfilment of the undertaking.
