COUNCIL DEMANDS ACTION IN WATER DISPUTE

A demand for strong action on the canal water situation has been tabled with the convener of the All-Parties Council, H.M. Habibullah, for the emergency meeting of the council called for tomorrow afternoon.

One resolution urges the Pakistani Government to quit the Commonwealth and another to approach the International Court of Justice to restrain India from diverting the Sutlej waters. The meeting will also consider suggestions to boycott Indian goods, break off diplomatic relations with her, and to organize public meetings to express indignation over India's unilateral action.
