Commenting on "Pakistan's campaign of vilification of India in connection with the Bhakra Canal," the LEADER says: "It will not pay Pakistanis to preach hatred." The paper adds. "The Pakistani allegation that India has committed riparian aggression and that India wants to starve Pakistanis is a baseless lie; that India's attitude is perfectly correct is proved by the fact that her decision to use the waters of the Sutlej to feed the Bhakra Canal is in conformity with the World Bank's plan for distribution of the waters of the rivers of the Indus Basin. According to that plan, the waters of the Sutlej, the Beas, and the Ravi are India's."
