CANAL WATER

A public meeting held under the auspices of the Peshawar City Moslem League has passed a resolution condemning India's action in diverting the Sutlej waters. The resolution suggests to the Pakistan Government that protests should be sent to the United Nations. The women's branch of the Punjab Moslem League has expressed grave concern over the "inhuman and aggressive" Indian action. In a resolution, it has urged the Government to take some definite action to meet the danger and assured the Government of full support by the women of the Punjab. (Karachi, English, July 16, 1954) Frontier Chief Minister, Sardar Abdur Rashid, has called upon all political parties to close their ranks to face the threat to Pakistan created by India's diversion of Sutlej waters.
