As you can see from the attached press lease, we have not been dealt with favorably in the summary of the case presented. I did not feel that it was necessary to make a formal complaint at this point but took the opportunity of addressing my letter — a copy of which is enclosed — to Miss Marcia Cooper, who handles most of these releases.

Certainly this release does not affect the course of the debate in the Security Council, but there is room here for a complaint which I feel is contained in my letter to Miss Cooper.
