The lack of records of use of water on crops, and rainfall and run-off stream flow records of Helman Basin may necessitate use of data from adjacent areas such as Euphrates, Nile, and Indus. These records located in various localities such as the principal reclamation office at Denver Colorado, The Library of Congress Washington, D. C. and Hydrological Offices at London, Cairo, Baghdad and New Delhi.

A lack of crop rainfall and stream flow records in Helmand River Basin may make it desirable to supplement available data with extra data from adjacent areas. These records may be found in principal engineering office of the Bureau of Reclamation, Denver, Colorado or at Hydrological Offices, London, Cairo, New Dehli, and Baghdad.

Possibly interviews with Hydrological Officers at these cities may bring forth additional data bearing on the question.
