## THE MIYAKO HOTEL, KYOTO.

Hako-Zaki-no-miya.

Located at Hako-zaki-machi, Kasuga gun, Chikuzen Province.

Its location was changed so that it now faces toward Fusan in Korea.

Dedicated to:

Ojin Tenno

Jingo Kogo (his mother)

Tamayori hime no mikoto (his aunt.

Ojin Tenno is the main deity, the others are secondary. The shrine was erected at the place where the placenta of Ojin Tenno is buried. The spot is enclosed by a stone fence and a pine tree marks the place. This tree is said to be a descendant of the original tree which was planted at the time of burial&

The shrine buildings have been burned several times and are often repaired, on account of the attacks of white ants. The present buildings date from 1546 A. D. But now being greatly repaired

In front of the main shrine is a gate which bears the Tekkoku to tuku" meaning "Enemy countries surrender" autographed by Emperor Dai go. Whenever the country was threatened by a foreign foe divine favor was always invoked at this shrine to save the nation. Emperor Dai-go also wrote these words 37 times because he was 37 years old in an album which is shown at the shrine at the present time.

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
