The Sea of Galilee's Water Level Rises Unexpectedly

Today's YEDIOT AHRONOT reports on
the sharp rise in water level in the Sea
of Galilee over the past 24 hours --
almost 4 inches. The level had reached
-211.29 (under Sea Level). The
Administration of the Sea of Galilee
said that the heavy rains still pouring
down in the region, and the fact that
the water reservoirs in the Golan
Heights are full, caused this unexpected
rise over the past 24 hours. Since the
beginning of the season, the level has
risen 6 feet. The improvement of the
Sea of the Galilee's condition can be
seen by the human eye -- many areas
which were previously dry or covered
with flora before are now under water.
