## Mesut Yilmaz New Prime Minister of the Republic of Turkey

Mesut Yilmaz became Prime Minister of the Republic of Turkey in June, 1991 after serving in a number of government positions, including more than three years as the country's foreign minister.

With his election as chairman of the Motherland Party on June 15, 1991, Mr. Yilmaz, who was born in 1947, became one of the youngest Prime Ministers in three decades.

Mr. Yilmaz, a founding member of the Motherland Party, served as Foreign Minister in the government of President Turgut Ozal from December 1987 to February 1990. He was a State Minister and government spokesman in President Ozal's first administration from 1983 until 1986, when he was named Culture and Tourism Minister. In 1987, he was elected a deputy to the Grand National Assembly (Parliament) from Rize.

Born in Istanbul, Mr. Yilmaz graduated from Ankara University in 1971 and studied for a master's degree at Cologne University in Germany. He held a number of management positions in private industry before joining Mr. Ozal in forming the Motherland Party.

Mr. Yilmaz speaks German and English. He is married and the father of two children.
