Dedicated to Umugi hime no mikoto and Kisagahi hime no mikoto.

These two kami are two shellfigh. When 0 kuni nushi was burned to death by the trickery of his brothers, his mother ascended to Heaven and prayed the Heavenly kami to restore him to life. Then the kami of Heaven sent these two Shellfish down with her, saying that she should burn the shell of Kisagahi and crushiit into a powder, and that she should take the water from the shell of Umugi and mix the powder with it to make a paste, which should be spread entirely over the body of 0 kuni nushi.

When these instructions were followed 0 kuni nushi was restored to life, and these two shell fish in time came to be regarded as kami.

The shells are of the Conch variety.

Oye Ehrine in the Province of Inaba.

Dedicated to Umugi hime no mikoto and Kisagahi hime no mikoto.
