Shunki korei sai March 22nd.

Early in the morning a place is prepared for the ceremony in front of the Kagura den. New straw ^{or reed} matting is spread upon which is placed a small Sakaki tree on which the soul of the God is supposed to rest, (Himorogi).

8 A.M. the Guji and other officials come to this place, the Guji offers tamagushi and worships at a distance. (?)

"Most fearful and Awe Inspiring Kami, we worship you with prayers from this distant place"

They worship the divine souls of the departed emperors in the Imperial Soul Hall of the Imperial Palace, i.e, the Korei den.



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
