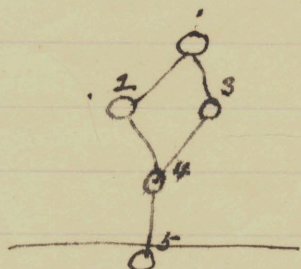

[Ten = heaven, sho = light, ko = emperor or master, dai = great, jin = god]

Asama-jinja - the shrine on Mt Fuji -

on the tops of all hills, in almost impassable places, old shrines to
 o'Anamuchi-no-mikoto. He must have owned all the land on
 the Western side of the country - He is the same god worshipped at Izumo

There is no praying at the shrines, only cleaning, washing and
 throwing off impurities - harai = blow or brush away -

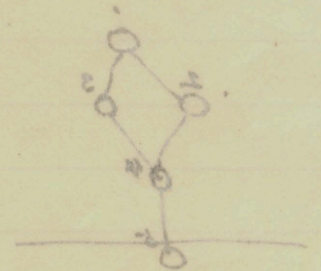
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
