

Ameno minaka nushi - (the Japanese name)
 [Ame = heaven, no = of, minaka = center, nushi = master, no = of, Kami = god]
 or Ten shōko daijin (the Chinese name)

[Ten = heaven, shō = light, ko = emperor or master, dai = great, jin = god]

2 & 3 Izanagi & Izanami - (a sort of Adam & eve.)

4. Amaterasu o'kami -

5. Jimmu Tensu - 1st Emperor - also called Hoho
demi no mikoto - or Daikotoku -

All the gods below Jimmu Tensu, were human beings - those above,
celestial bodies -

all those above the line, given 1st rank -

Temples dedicated to royal family called gingu -

Asama-jinja - the shrine on Mt. Fuji -

on the tops of all hills, in almost impossible places, old shrines to
o'anamuchi-no-mikoto - He must have owned all the land on
the Western side of the country - He is the same god worshipped at Izumo

There is no praying at the shrines, only cleaning, washing and
throwing off impurities - harai = blow or brush away -
