Please let me know how much the artist is charging me for each drawing. I have quite a number I wish to have made if it is not too expensive, so I will judge by the price of these.

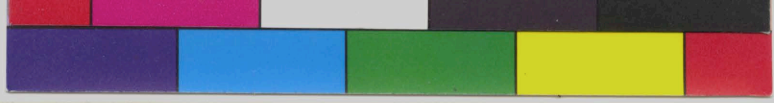
I hope you will be able to find an artist who will do the work well but who will not charge a fancy price.
