

P. B. BASS SR., 70, REALTY DEALER SINCE 1895, DIES

Perkins Burnham Bass Sr., a Chicago real estate dealer since 1895, died yesterday in the Presbyterian hospital following an operation four weeks ago. He was 70 years old. His home was at 1027 Grove street, Evanston.

Mr. Bass was born in Kankakee county and came to Chicago with his parents when he was a small child. He was graduated from Northwestern university in 1888. Since 1911 he had

been president of his own real estate concern with offices at 140 South Dearborn street. He was a former president of the Chicago Real Estate Board.

Surviving are his widow, Mary, and three children, Perkins Burnham Bass Jr., Mrs. A. A. McLean, and Mrs. Frank E. Corliss. The funeral will be held at 4 p. m. tomorrow in the chapel of Rosehill cemetery.
